Overview

Barton Civil's 3rd school project on the Milton Keynes School Framework (now converted to SCAPE) required an enabling earthworks scheme to prepare the site for the construction of a new £22m secondary school with sports hall, SEN building, and MUGA and synthetic pitches. The overall site being 45,000m².



Scope of work:

Barton Civils were contracted to provide an earthworks and civil engineering package for the development of a new £22m secondary school at Kents Hill, Milton Keynes. Barton Civils partnered with Group company Barton Plant to provide the earth works on site, ahead of secondary works in August 2016, which include drainage and foundation work.

The project included a cut of 12,000m³ and a fill of 23,000m³ including piling mats for 3 buildings using GPS guided dozers/excavators and preparation of sports pitches to Sport England specification.

Additional work included Foul and storm drainage including connections to existing runs and attenuation tank.

We also implemented the formation of a 200 space car park installed to provide parking and welfare for the main contractor during the works, with the area being surfaced on completion to form the permanent works.

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
